Summer Reservation Policies:

- Summer Season Pass Holders and 6-Pack Lift Ticket Holders: We only require advance reservations for Aerial Park and Picnics. Please call the front desk at 518-636-3699 ext. for reservations.
- All Other Summer Guests: Advance Reservations are required at WestMountain.com. Check in for all pre-reserved ticket and rental bookings is available outdoors at the ticket windows of the Main Lodge. After check in at the ticket windows, advance rental purchases can be picked up in the rental shop (across the courtyard from the Main Lodge). If you are renting and taking a lesson, please purchase in advance online and arrive well ahead of your lesson time to be at lesson line up in time.

Uphill Travel: West Mountain does not offer uphill travel except during summer operational hours and with the purchase of a ticket or season pass.

Smoking and Pets: Smoking and pets are not permitted on the property.

Safety Measures:

- All guests must have a signed waiver to receive a ticket or access band to participate in all activities. If purchasing online, the waiver is included in the transaction. If purchasing at the ticket window, you will be asked to sign a waiver upon arrival.
- All chairlift riders/hikers need to wear appropriate athletic footwear
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- Children riding the chairlift must be able to sit up alone next to an adult. We do not allow baby carriers on the lifts.

- All children under 18 must have a signed waiver by a parent and/or legal guardian.
- Keep the mountain clean. Do not litter. Throw all garbage in garbage cans.

COVID Safety Measures: Information will be available soon.

Vendors, Sales Personnel and Others: All Vendors, sales personnel, town and state representatives and others must have a scheduled meeting, delivery time, etc. with the appropriate West Mountain manager ahead of visiting WM. Please call the front desk upon arrival at 518-636-3699 ext. 0 for confirmation of scheduled visit and to be permitted entry. Masks are required.

Employee Health: All employees will continue to wear masks, monitor their health, and limit travel outside the area. If employees are not feeling well, they are required to stay home.
