Summer Reservation Policies:

- **Summer Season Pass Holders:** Summer Adventure Tickets are complimentary for summer season pass holders. Reservations for aerial adventure, mountain biking and scenic chairlift rides and hiking should be made online in advance at westmountain.com. The process is simple. Just input your summer season pass number and click Validate once your selections are in your cart. Buddy tickets (one per day per pass holder) can be purchased at the ticket window. Buddy tickets are 20% off the retail rate. Picnics (select the Picnic Add-On) and bike rentals can be added to your reservation online and are a separate fee. We will require you to show your summer season pass at check-in. The name on the ticket reservation must match the name on the season pass. Please check in at the ticket windows at the Main Lodge upon arrival.
- **Winter Season Pass Holders:** Summer Adventure Tickets are 15% off for winter season pass holders. Reservations for aerial adventure, mountain biking, mountaintop picnics, and scenic chairlift rides and hiking should be made online in advance at westmountain.com. The process is simple. Just input your season pass number and click Validate once your selections are in your cart. We will require you to show your winter season pass at check-in. The name on the ticket reservation must match the name on the season pass. Please check in at the ticket windows at the Main Lodge upon arrival.
- **All Other Summer Guests:** Advance Reservations are strongly recommended at WestMountain.com. Check in for all pre-reserved ticket and rental bookings is available outdoors at the ticket windows of the Main Lodge. After check in at the ticket windows, advance rental purchases can be picked up in the rental shop (across the courtyard from the Main Lodge). If you are renting and taking a lesson, please purchase in advance online and arrive well ahead of your lesson time to be at lesson line up in time.

Uphill Travel: West Mountain does not offer uphill travel except during summer operational hours and with the purchase of a ticket or season pass.

Smoking and Pets: Smoking and pets are not permitted on the property.

Safety Measures:

SUMMER SAFETY

BIKING/HIKING/LIFT RIDING/CLIMBING CODE:

All guests must check in at the ticket window at the Main Lodge upon arrival and have a signed waiver and a valid ticket or access band when visiting. Guests 12 and Under need to be accompanied by an adult. In order to ride the chairlift, children must be able to sit up next to an adult. Baby carriers, large coolers and back packs are not allowed on the lift. Do not bike/hike/climb alone. Be safe, wear a helmet when engaging in biking/climbing activities at West Mountain. Wear proper athletic shoes and gear for your visit. Know your ability and do not try to exceed it. If in doubt, seek help. You can always ask a mountain attendant for assistance. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or cannot be seen by other mountain users. Be aware of others on our mixed use trails. Observe all CLOSED TRAIL signs, barriers and caution ropes. Do not ride/hike/climb off designated trails. Do not disturb animals or plants on the mountain. No fires. smoking or pets are allowed on West Mountain property. Biking, Hiking, Climbing, or any other activity are not allowed on the property during non-business hours.

Mountain Biking SAFETY

- Purchase a ticket or season pass
- Wear a helmet
- Stay in Control
- Wear the Correct Riding Gear
- Ride Within your skill level
- Get to know the trail(s)
- Slow down for blind corners
- Watch for drainage ditches, water bars and other obstacles
- Obey signs and warnings
- Be aware of others on our mixed use trails
- Do not bike on trails when the mountain is not open
