



Slush Cup & Cardboard Sled Derby Details, Rules and Design Guidelines for March 27, 2022

Please join us at West Mountain for our always popular Slush Cup and Cardboard Sled Derby on March 27, 2022 from 2:30-4pm with Bobby and Susie Dick.

- 2:30-2:45am Slush Cup and Cardboard sled derby registration at the front desk. All participants will need to fill out an entry form and sign a waiver. Minors (under 18) will need a parent's signature on the waiver.
- Slush cup entry fee: valid lift ticket or season pass plus \$10 with costume/\$20 without costume
- Cardboard sled derby entry fee: \$10 per person/\$20 per team
- Cardboard sled derby design rules (below)
- 3pm Slush Cup begins on the Face with live announcing and amazing prizes
Immediately following is the cardboard sled derby in the tubing park

Rules and Design Guidelines Design Guidelines:

- Only regular cardboard, duct tape, paint, markers, and crayons can be used in the construction of the cardboard sled.
- Sleds cannot be wrapped in plastic or shrink wrapped.
- **No wood, glue, industrial adhesives, staples, rope or wire will be permitted on a sled.** Keep designs family friendly (NO PROFANITY ALLOWED)
- All Sleds must have a front, rear, bottom, and two sides.

Derby Rules:

- You must be 6 years or older to participate. Minors (under 18) will need a parent's signature on the waiver.
- Maximum of 3 participants per sled.
- Riders are not allowed to use their hands to push their sled down the hill once they have crossed the start line. Push Starts ONLY, NO running starts.
- Costumes are welcome and encouraged
- Participants are strongly encouraged to wear helmets. We have rental helmet in the rental shop available to rent.
- All sleds, parts, and participants must cross the finish line.
- In the case that none of the Teams make it across the finish line, the Race Winner will be based on the sled that made it the furthest distance over speed, provided the sled stays intact.

Prizes Awarded for...

- Best Time- (Whoever makes it across the finish line first)
- Best in Show- (best Costume and overall sled presentation)
- Best Crash

Derby details:

- All Sleds and Teams will meet in front of the Deck near the ticket windows 15 minutes after the Slush Cup.
- The Sleds and teams will use the lower tubing lanes to race. Start will be determined before the race.
- All sleds will line up on the lower tubing lanes and will begin at the same time. We may have to run more than one heat depending on number of sleds.
- The team/sled that makes it across the finish line first WINS. We will use hand times if we run more than one heat of sleds☺

The Cardboard Sled will be inspected by a West Mountain representative at the time of registration.
