



## Slush Cup & Cardboard Sled Derby Details, Rules and Design Guidelines for March 26, 2023

Please join us at West Mountain for our always popular Slush Cup and Cardboard Sled Derby on Sunday, March 26, 2023 from 1:30pm-5:30pm

### Event Schedule:

1:30-2:30pm Register on-site (limited to the first 100 registrants) for the Slush Cup at the Front Desk in the Main Lodge. Registration is first come, first serve. Minors (under 18) will need a parent's signature on the waiver.

3-4pm Register on-site at the Front Desk in the Main Lodge for the Cardboard Sled Derby (rules below). Minors (under 18) will need a parent's signature on the waiver.

2:45pm All Slush Cup Competitors need to be at the start line on the North Face trail and lined up in bib order.

3:00pm Start of the Slush Cup

4:15 All Cardboard Sled Derby participants meet at the entrance to the tubing park to receive instructions.

4:30pm Start of the Cardboard Sled Derby in the Tubing Park

Slush Cup Fee: \$20 (50% off if wearing a costume). The fee does not include the lift ticket.

Cardboard Sled Derby Fee: \$10 per Individual/\$20 per team. There is not a discount if you come in costume for the sled derby, but costumes are fun for this event!

Please Note: We love animals, but we kindly request they be left at home for this event. Outside alcohol and coolers are not permitted.

### Derby Design Guidelines

- Only regular cardboard, duct tape, paint, markers, and crayons can be used in the construction of the cardboard sled.
- Sleds cannot be wrapped in plastic or shrink wrapped.
- **No wood, glue, industrial adhesives, staples, rope or wire will be permitted on a sled.** Keep designs family friendly.
- All Sleds must have a front, rear, bottom, and two sides.

### Derby Rules:

- You must be 6 years or older to participate. Minors (under 18) will need a parent's signature on the waiver.
- Maximum of 3 participants per sled.
- Riders are not allowed to use their hands to push their sled down the hill once they have crossed the start line. Push Starts ONLY, NO running starts.
- Costumes are welcome and encouraged.

- Participants are strongly encouraged to wear helmets. We have rental helmet in the rental shop available to rent.
- All sleds, parts, and participants must cross the finish line.
- In the case that none of the Teams make it across the finish line, the Race Winner will be based on the sled that made it the furthest distance over speed, provided the sled stays intact.

Derby details:

- The Sleds and teams will use the lower tubing lanes to race. Start will be determined before the race.
- All sleds will line up on the lower tubing lanes and will begin at the same time. We may have to run more than one heat depending on number of sleds.
- The team/sled that makes it across the finish line first WINS.

Prizes for Slush Cup and Sled Derby Awarded for...

- Best Time- (Whoever makes it across the finish line first)
- Best in Show- (best Costume and overall sled presentation)
- Best Crash

The Cardboard Sled will be inspected by a West Mountain representative at the time of registration.
